The download button for the program is usually located in the middle of the page. It will be a pale green button labeled "Download Now" that turns yellow when your mouse cursor hovers over it.

Your download should begin immediately. When the download is complete, open and run the installation program.

Each download is different, so be sure to read the fine print and pay attention to what you are allowing to install on your computer.
